Adjective + Noun

The following activity is designed to help pair an adjective and a noun. Cut out the adjectives (big, small, black, brown) and the nouns (cat, dog, shoe). Turn them over and put them facing down in two piles. Have the client pick an adjective and a noun. Then, have the client pick the appropriate picture. You can either cut out the pictures (that way you can make the task easier with only two options) or keep them in tact in order to make the activity harder.

Tips: If you print the following page on cardstock, then it will help make the activity more durable. Laminating will also help with the durability.
